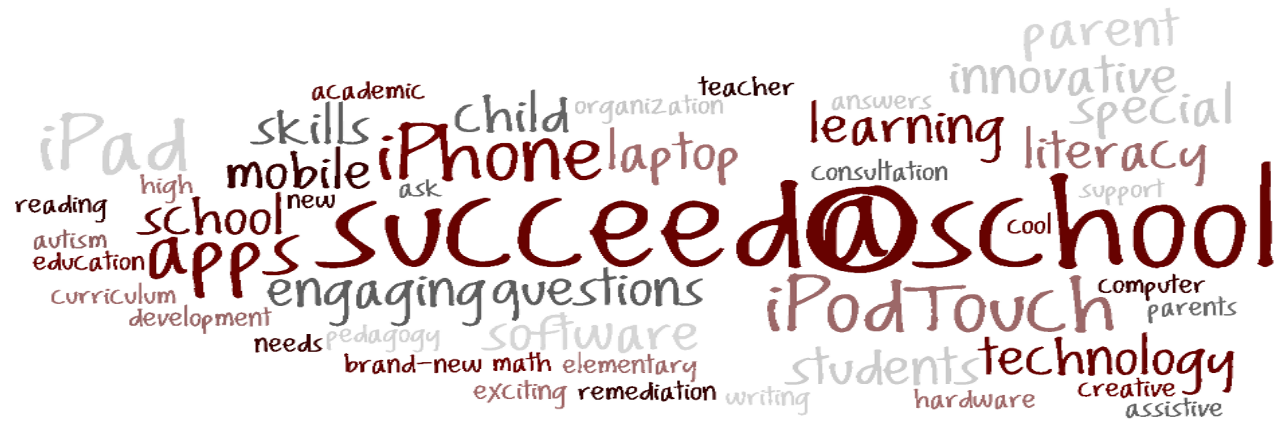

Assistive Technology, IDEA, and IEP

Assistive Technology is any item, software, or system that can be used in everyday life to increase and improve lives of those with a disability. There are two types of AT: low tech and high tech devices.

The Individuals with Disabilities Act also known as IDEA is a law to protect those with disabilities as well as providing FAPE (free and appropriate public education).

Individualized Education Program also known as an IEP is a document that describes an individual child's strengths and weaknesses as well as any services, and their educational plan and goals that should be achieved for the following school year.



6 Examples of Assistive Technology

Low Tech Examples:

- Adapted furniture- Ex. Rise and fall tables or kidney bean tables for those who may have physical disabilities or are in a wheelchair
- Pencil grip- helpful for those who lack fine motor skills
- Correction tape- to fix a word or sentence when writing
- Visual Timer- students are able to visually depict how much time they have left
- Copy of teachers notes- for students who have trouble with auditory processing

High Tech Examples:

- Talking calculators- for those who have trouble entering accurate keys and to verify the answer before putting it on paper
- Tobii Technology- communication device for those who might have Cerebral Palsy
- Text-to-Speech Software- use of classroom computer if child has difficulty with handwriting
- Outlining Software- for those who struggle with organizing their thoughts/preparing for tests
